State and independent analyses estimate that federal cuts will result in about 330,000 Illinois residents losing coverage.

Because nearly 40% of non-elderly adults covered by Medicaid have a mental health or substance use disorder, the loss could leave a glaring gap for the state to address.

- * Coverage losses will affect your client base and revenue.
- * Reimbursement reductions and delays are likely.
- * New eligibility rules will increase paperwork and billing complexity, raising audit risks for your team.

What The State Is Doing

Illinois' new state budget set a record at \$55.1B and took effect July 1. The spending package reflects strong commitments to human services, with notable investments in housing and community supports. But the budget relies on quick fixes: \$700 million in new taxes are projected to fund a chunk of the budget along with more than \$500M in one-time revenues (ARPA reimbursement, fund sweeps and delayed transfers, etc.). These may not fully offset major federal Medicaid cuts. For providers, the message is clear: long-term state support remains uncertain.
