H.R. 1 (OBBBA) caps the provider tax — a state-level tax on healthcare providers and a key Medicaid financing tool that Utah uses to secure federal matching funds. Utah could be forced to choose between sustaining crisis services and supporting long term community-based care, putting recent investments in crisis stabilization units, mobile outreach, and the 988 system at risk.

Governor Cox has called for more strategic investments and a return to fiscal responsibility after a period of economic volatility. His office's FY2026 budget reflects a desire to absorb costs rather than make deep Medicaid cuts. Whether this approach is sustainable remains to be seen.
